We set the standard for lifeguard training and certify Canada's National Lifeguards.

The Lifesaving Society establishes aquatic safety standards and consults on aquatic safety issues for the aquatic industry and governments. The Society offers a suite of services to help aquatic facility operators maintain and improve safe pool and waterfront

operations. We perform aquatic safety audits and serve as experts in legal cases involving aquatic safety issues.

The Society represents Canada internationally in the Royal Life Saving Society and the International Life Saving Federation. We are the governing body for lifesaving sport – a sport recognized by the International Olympic Committee and the Commonwealth Games Federation. Provincial and national championships showcase the professionalism of our lifeguards. National Lifesaving Teams represent Canada in international competitions.
