Job Description: Lifesaving Society Examiner

Purpose

Examiners are responsible for the evaluation and certification of candidates for Lifesaving Society lifesaving, first aid and lifeguarding awards.

Certification

Appointed by the Lifesaving Society for a two-year term; may recertify for additional two-year terms through the Society's recertification process.

Reporting Relationship

To the Lifesaving Society.

Responsibilities

Lifesaving Society Examiners:

- 1. Evaluate and certify candidates for Lifesaving Society lifesaving, first aid and lifeguarding certifications:
 - o in the topical streams in which they are appropriately qualified, and
 - o in accordance with the policies, procedures and standards of the Society and the Leadership Code of Conduct.
- 2. Assure the quality and integrity of the Society's programs through the application of the requirements specified in the Society's award guides.
- 3. Act as resources to Lifesaving Society instructors in matters related to Lifesaving Society evaluation standards.
- 4. Complete all administrative requirements in a timely manner including test sheets.
- 5. Assist in the identification, recruitment and development of potential Examiners.
- 6. Attend Examiner workshops and clinics as required.

Experienced Examiners who examine with apprenticing examiners undertake additional responsibilities:

- 7. Provide effective apprenticeship experiences for examiner candidates, evaluate their performance, and provide guidance for their professional development.
- 8. Complete the required apprenticeship training records and reports.
