Job Description: Lifesaving Society Trainer

Purpose

Trainers are responsible for preparing candidates to assume leadership roles as Lifesaving Society Instructors, Examiners, and Coaches.

Certification

Certified by the Lifesaving Society for a two-year term; may re-certify for additional two-year terms through the Society's recertification process.

Reporting Relationship

To the Lifesaving Society.

Responsibilities

Lifesaving Society Trainers:

- Teach, evaluate, and certify candidates for Lifesaving Society Instructor, Examiner and Coach certifications:
 - o in the topical streams in which they are appropriately qualified, and
 - o in accordance with the policies, procedures and standards of the Society and the Leadership Code of Conduct.
- 2. Assure the quality and integrity of the Society's leadership training programs through current professional knowledge and expertise in learning, teaching, evaluation, and mentoring.
- 3. Act as expert resources in matters related to learning, teaching, evaluating, and mentoring within the Society's leadership training system.
- 4. Deliver Lifesaving Society leadership courses on an ongoing basis and leadership update clinics as required.
- 5. Complete all administrative requirements in a timely manner.
- 6. Provide apprenticeship, professional development opportunities, and guidance for Trainer candidates as assigned.
- 7. Assist in the identification, recruitment and development of potential Trainers.
- 8. Attend Trainer workshops and clinics as required.
