COVID-19 Update from the Society

The Society continues to monitor the COVID-19 situation and has the following updates:

Curbside Pickup

Curbside pickup is now available for orders. As of June 1, 2020, curbside pickup is available between 1-4pm Mondays-Friday. Special request pick up times may be considered outside these hours by contacting shop@lifesaving.org.

Certification Extensions

The Lifesaving Society has extended the currency of all certifications that would no longer be current after March 1, 2020. These awards will be extended for 3 months once facilities are permitted by Public Health to re-open. The Government of Alberta's Medical Director of Occupational Health and Safety has permitted First Aid certifications to be extended as well.

The Government of Alberta has indicated that recreation centres fit into Stage 3 of the Alberta Relaunch plan. The Government of Northwest Territories has indicated that aquatic staff training may begin in phase 2 and that Swimming Pools would be permitted to re-open in phase 3.

To prepare for relaunch the Society will publish guidelines for organizations to consider when planning to open their facilities. We will also host an online session in June for members to review the guidelines and answer questions.
