#### Water Smart® Year in Review

The COVID-19 pandemic presented new challenges and changed how we deliver our Water Smart education initiatives. Rather than being in the community teaching water safety we were pushed to find new ways to get our message across. During National Drowning Prevention Week we used online water safety messaging to reinforce the need for caution around unsupervised waterfronts.

This year we were also confronted with one of the worst years of media reported fatal drownings in Alberta's recent history. With record attendance at many unsupervised public waterfronts there was a rise in the number of media reported fatal drownings. Mitigating fatal drownings means educating the public on the dangers that water can present which led to the development of the Grade 3 Be Water Smart® Program.

With the support of the Alberta Injury Prevention Centre, we developed an educational module to help change water safety related behaviours in elementary aged students. This free one hour program provides a foundational understanding of water safe behaviours. Our Water Smart Coordinator, Kelsey, has been doing a fantastic job facilitating the online and socially distanced delivery of the program. If you missed the original application date all resources are available for free on our website!

This has been a challenging year but the Lifesaving Society took advantage of online resources and made an investment into future education. We are excited to continue this important work in the upcoming 2021 year of Water Smart®!
