Grade Three Water Smart® Program

We are so excited to share the success of the launch of our Grade 3 Be Water Smart® Program! We developed three different delivery methods to help us combat the restrictions put in place due to the pandemic: In-person, teacher-led, and online learning. This made it possible to enter classrooms safely, as well as give our hard-working teachers the flexibility needed during this uncertain time.

The objectives of this program are to: identify the drowning problem, hazard identification, lifejacket use and importance, drowning recognition and response, boating safety, cold water and ice safety. All lesson plans are designed to ensure the learner experiences practical application of knowledge, skills and judgment.

We were able to double our initial goal of putting 100 students through the free program. We saw an increase in knowledge in approximately 93% of the content, with an average of 18.5% growth in each category, exhibiting great success in our first launch.

Planned Re-opening of Aquatic Facilities

When planning to re-open your aquatic facility this year utilizing certified staff will be essential. All certification extensions in Alberta have now been completed as of December 31, 2020. As such it is recommended that facilities complete a recertification of aquatic staff if required prior to re-opening their facility to the public.

The COVID-19 pandemic has taught us to plan ahead and that the future remains unknown. As such all certification holders are encouraged to actively plan and re-certify their awards early. Contact the Society if your facility needs assistance in scheduling a recertification in the event you do not have a qualified staff member to deliver the training once facilities are permitted to resume operations.

Affiliate delivery partners are reminded to keep their course listings on the Lifesaving Society website current and updated so members know where courses and recertifications can be found. This would include removing any courses that have been cancelled or adding new courses on that may be scheduled.
