- Provide direction and support to all lifeguard and instructional staff and instill the Y's core values of caring, respect, responsibility and honesty
- Be the lead in emergency situations and assist the Aquatic Manager in the provision of aquatic instructional or recreational programs
- Work efficiently and effectively, fulfilling shift supervisor duties and provides guidance and leadership to aquatic staff
- You are flexible and have the ability to work independently, while building relationships with our members
- Coordinate, supervise and deliver instruction for First Aid, Advanced Courses, and Swim Lessons
- Ensures first aid supplies, emergency equipment and program equipment are in order and performs safety inspections, as required
- Monitors the general safety and maintenance of the pool deck, change rooms, and associated areas, and reports concerns to the appropriate department
- Organizes and ensures the pool is set up for scheduled activities and that user needs are sufficiently met
- Ensures that all awards or certifications are kept current and up to date
- Ability to work a variety of shifts, including daytime, evenings and weekends
