United Nations Adopts Resolution on Drowning Prevention

We are thrilled to advise that the UN Resolution on Drowning Prevention was approved by the United Nations General Assembly on Wednesday, April 28, 2021.

The United Nations resolution on drowning prevention is a sentinel step that will focus attention and action on this highly preventable public health problem of drowning. It will increase awareness and action by United Nations agencies to reduce drowning. This resolution will encourage national governments to reduce drowning burden through effective policies and legislation, research and support community drowning prevention actions.

This first United Nations resolution on prevention Canada co-sponsored. Canada's support for this resolution aligns with global and national priorities for safe activities and health for all.
