Lifesaving Society Program Revisions

Updates to Bronze Medal Awards, and 2021 Mandatory Updates

Over the last few years, the Bronze Medal Awards have gone under an extensive review process and as a result the National Programs have been revised:

- To reflect the Society's current research into drowning in Canada including the incidence and consequences of non-fatal drowning;
- To focus on the core areas of competency in water rescue: skills, knowledge, fitness and judgement;
- To improve skill progressions for a logical and seamless flow into National Lifeguard and to set candidates up for success as they move through the Society's lifesaving, assistant lifeguard, and lifeguard continuum.

This is one of the largest program revisions in the Society's history and is currently being rolled out across the country.

Completing the Update

The Mandatory Update needs to be completed via the Lifesaving Society Online Academy (<u>https://courses.lifesaving.org/</u>). This update includes an overview and orientation to the changes reflected in the Bronze Medal Awards programs and resources. All participants that complete the update will receive the required literature and resources to deliver the new programs.

The update is for all Lifesaving Trainers and Instructors who deliver, teach, and evaluate Lifesaving Society Leadership and/or candidate level Lifesaving Programs. These leadership volunteers are to complete the **Update Process** below.

The Update Process

Lifesaving Trainers and Instructors must complete the following steps:

- Register and complete the Online 2021 Bronze Medals Mandatory Update via the Lifesaving Society Online Course Academy
- Review and understand the Mandatory Update Implementation Timeline
- Review and understand changes to Policies and Procedures
- Review and understand changes to Program Resources
- Review and understand changes to Program Content
- Receive and review New Program Resources

New Program Resources

New and revised resources include the following:

- The **Bronze Medals Award Guide** has been completely revised and updated. This edition of the Award Guide replaces all previous editions.
- The **Bronze Medals Lesson Plans** have been completely revised & updated. They are now aligned to the Leadership Competency Model. Activities in the new lesson plans are less prescriptive & reinforce Instructor's application of knowledge, skills, and attitudes while planning and teaching Bronze Medal courses.
- The **Bronze Cross Course Book** is a new resource that features content updates for the Bronze Cross Program. The Bronze Cross Course Book is the primary resource for Bronze Cross candidates. It contains relevant information to assistant lifeguards that is not outlined within the Canadian Lifesaving Manual.
- The Test Sheets have been completely revised and updated

The Canadian Lifesaving Manual remains the primary candidate resource for the Bronze Star and Bronze Medallion programs.

• Launch of Updated LSI Course

December 31, 2021

- Previous Bronze Medals Retired
- Affiliates and Facilities Must Transition to New Bronze Program

January 1, 2022

• All Lifesaving Trainers and Instructors wishing deliver Bronze Programs must complete the Mandatory Update

Note:

- In order to deliver LSI courses after July 31, 2021, Lifesaving Trainers must complete the Mandatory Update
- In order to deliver the New Bronze courses Lifesaving Instructors must complete the Mandatory Update or must be certified on or after August 1, 2021
