## **Cold Water Worries - Staying Safe**



Canadian water is cold ALL year round. However, this is especially true come Fall season. There are many things we need to keep in mind when staying safe in, out and around water this chilly time of year. Our bodies experience cold water shock when submerged in these icy temperatures, making drowning likely for even the strongest of swimmers. Here are some things you can do to stay safe:

- Always keep children within arm's reach
- Wear a lifejacket when around water
- Keep your dogs on a leash
- Learn about the water and weather conditions prior to planning a day outdoors
- Always read safety signage by parks, bridges, and bodies of water
- Do not attempt to swim out and rescue people or animals in deep water. Instead, immediately call
  9-1-1 to activate Emergency Services.
