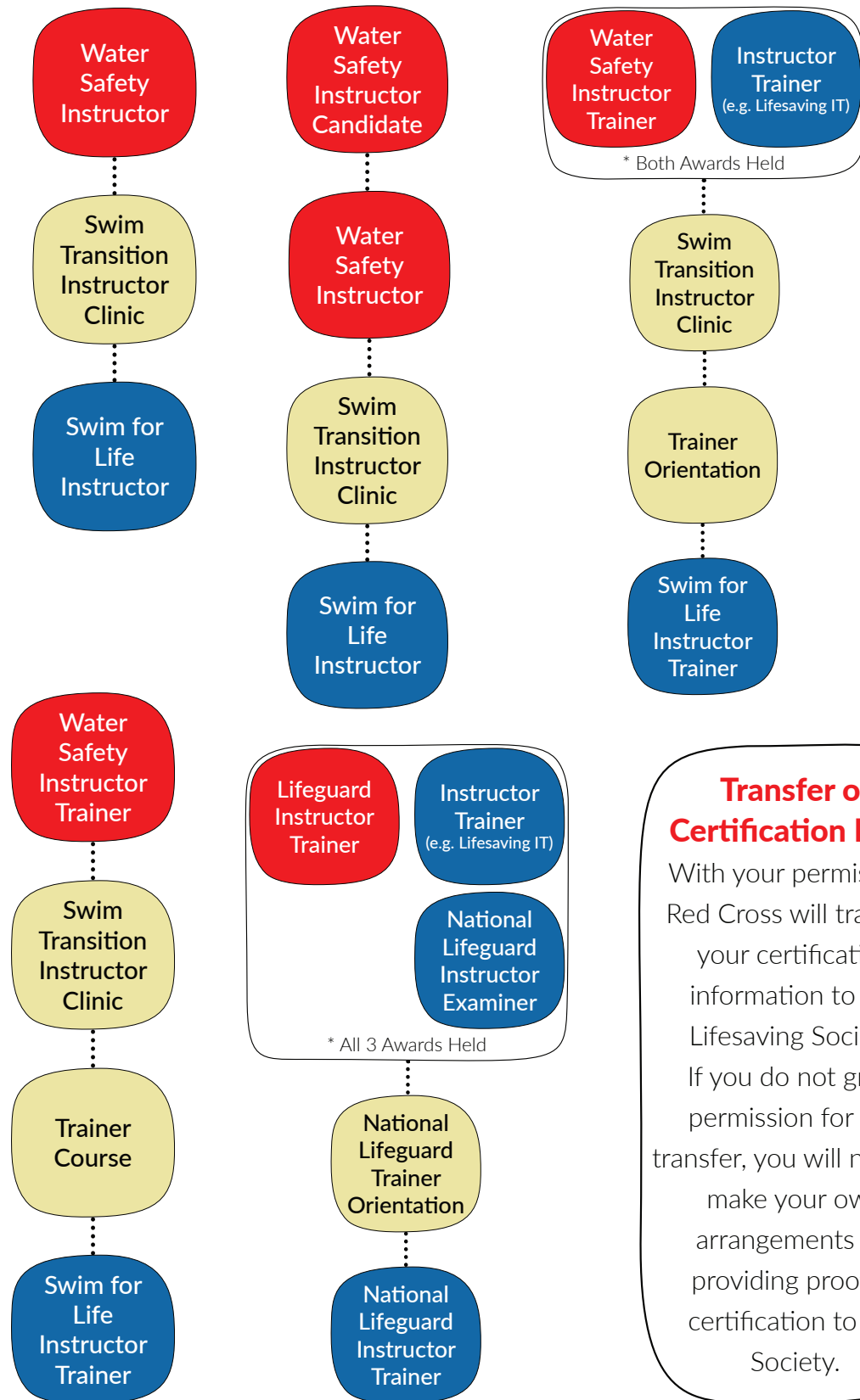


Instructor Pathways



Transfer of Certification Data
 With your permission, Red Cross will transfer your certification information to the Lifesaving Society. If you do not grant permission for this transfer, you will need to make your own arrangements for providing proof of certification to the Society.

Red Cross to Lifesaving Society Transition Pathways

Canadian Red Cross and Lifesaving Society Canada have established a special Swim Transition process to be completed on or before December 31, 2022.

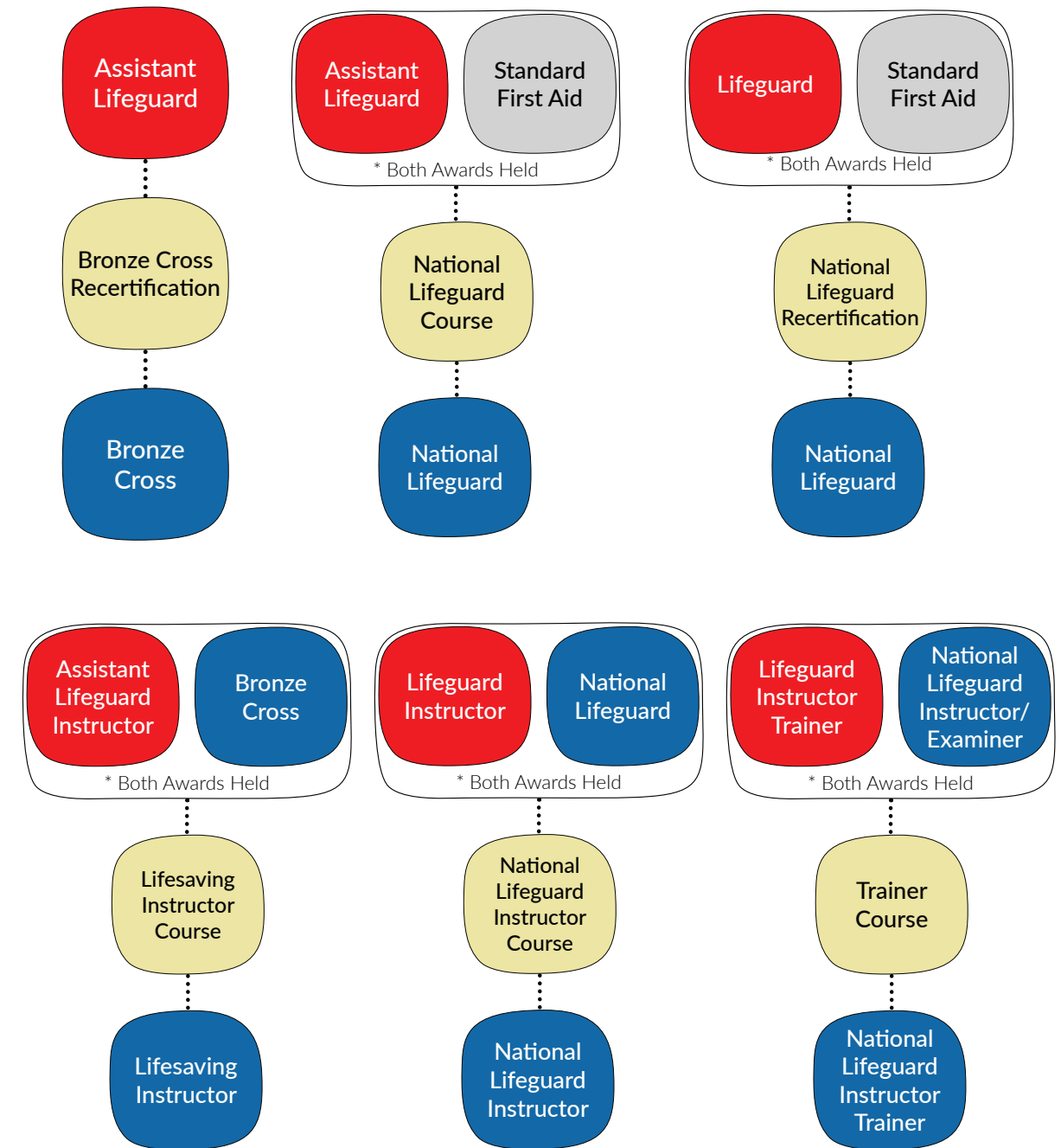
This is a limited-time opportunity to attain Lifesaving Society certifications via the Swim Transition process. These pathways recognize and acknowledge the competencies earned in Red Cross certifications while providing the knowledge and resources critical for success as a Lifesaving Society instructor, lifeguard, or trainer.

Any co-teach requirements associated with a Lifesaving Society certification during the transition period have been waived.

After December 31, 2022, Red Cross Instructors, Instructor Trainers, and Lifeguards would complete all normal Lifesaving Society certification requirements and pay applicable certification fees.

If you are in the process of completing a certification with the Canadian Red Cross, please complete the requirements to earn your Canadian Red Cross certification, then follow the appropriate steps to transition to Lifesaving Society certification.
