No Ice is Without Some Risk!



No ice is without some risk...minimize your risk! It is critical that the ice quality or type of ice is evaluated before your use. Clear, hard, new ice is the only kind of ice recommended for travel. You want to avoid:

- · Areas of slush on the ice
- Open holes or open water
- Ice on or near moving water i.e. rivers, currents
- Ice that has thawed and refrozen
- Pressure ridges
