World Drowning Prevention Day 25 July

Anyone can drown, no one should.

Last year the UN General Assembly adopted a Resolution on Global Drowning prevention in which July 25th was designated to be the yearly World Drowning Prevention Day (WDPD) and the World Health Organization (WHO) was invited to coordinate actions and facilitate observance of this day.

The purpose of the WDPD is to raise awareness of drowning prevention and celebrate the actions and initiatives that lifesaving organizations around the world are taking to prevent it.

As we approach this year's event, we would like to inform you about this year's key theme, launched by the WHO:

"Do one thing to prevent drowning".

This theme is an invitation to take one concrete action to advance drowning prevention, something all of us can do, individually or in groups. Visit the WHO website to learn more about the campaign for WDPD 2022.
