I, _____ (name), recognize that the athlete(s) listed below, are authorized to participate in the 2022 Canadian Surf Lifesaving Championship as an exhibition with no opportunity for points or medals, as this is a pilot project to assess the feasibility of formally including 14-year-old athletes in future Canadian Lifesaving Championships. I have a responsibility to ensure that the athlete(s) listed below will only be allowed to compete in events in which they are both physically and technically competent. I further recognize that the organizing committee, the Lifesaving Society Canada or its representatives may revoke any athlete's authorization to compete for an event or the entire Championship, should they deem it necessary for safety or other purposes, with no possibility to protest or appeal. Lastly, I recognize that 14-year-old athletes cannot compete in the open category, cannot use fiberglass fins and will only be allowed to compete in Beach Flags, if there are enough 14-year-old athletes for this event to be held, all of which is determined by the meet management committee.
