## **The Opportunity**

Lifeguard I is responsible for monitoring the safety of patrons, preventing harm or injury to staff and the public, and instructing learn to swim and intro to lifeguard programs. Ensures the safety and well-being of patrons through education and training opportunities. Performs rescues and medical support as required. Ensures effective, efficient, and safe operations while maintaining aquatic procedures and providing a clean work environment. Lifeguard I staff have the additional possibility of acting in a mentor capacity to other staff, that can provide direction to on-deck shift operations and customer service.

## Responsibilities

- Warns swimmers of improper activities or danger and enforces pool regulations and water safety policies.
- Administers first aid in the event of an injury, rescues swimmers in distress or danger or drowning, and administers CPR and/or artificial respiration, if necessary.
- Teaches swimming techniques, strokes, and water safety rules to students with varying swimming abilities.
- Assists more experienced swimmers to enhance their swimming abilities.
- Assessing the progress of swimmers and adjusting teaching programs accordingly.
- Monitoring students to prevent accidents and injuries.
- Implementing ground rules for each swim session.
- Plans swimming lessons that consider a swimmer's abilities and progressive development.
- Identifying incorrect swimming techniques and correcting students accordingly.
- Ensuring that the swimming pool is kept clean and tidy.
- Provides exceptional customer service
- Must be able to work with patrons of varying ages, in independent and team situations.
