<b>Purpose</b>	<p>The Drayton Valley Lifesavers Competition Management Committee has a safety and emergency plan for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The general safety of athletes, competition personnel, and spectators during the competition.</li> <li>• The Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre personnel and procedures are in place in case of minor or major incidents involving injury or illness of competitors, competition personnel and spectators.</li> </ul> <p>The following overview will outline the facility that will be utilized during the Drayton Valley Lifesavers Sport Competition. It will clearly identify those authorized persons to initiate the Safety and Emergency Plan and outline command and control functions. General procedures can be found in the Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre Emergency Procedures, in conjunction with Alberta Legislation and Regulations pertaining to pool operations.</p>
<b>Competition Personnel</b>	<p>The host has a designated Safety Officer. The designated Safety Officer is to liaise with Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre staff regarding competition safety. Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre staff will be required to report and document any incidents that occur at the facility during the event.</p> <p>Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre staff will be responsible for initiating the Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre Emergency Safety Plan.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Contact Information: Ricochet Oil Corp. <b>Operational Procedures</b>	Operational procedures require the facility to meet the minimum Alberta Legislation and Regulations. Lifesaving sport competition may require temporary alterations to these, for example, circulation may need to be turned down/off to minimize the movement of the manikins once they are placed.
<b>Emergency Procedures</b>	The Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre staff will notify the appointed Safety Officer of any major incident that occurs on site including any drowning, resuscitation, suspected spinal injury and possible fracture. The Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre will be supervised by Lifesaving Society certified National Lifeguards that are employed by the Town of Drayton Valley. Employees will deal with emergencies per the Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre emergency procedures. The Drayton Valley Lifesavers Competition Committee will assist with managing the participants and volunteers during an emergency.
<b>Code of Conduct</b>	All volunteers, officials, competitors, and coaches must adhere to the Codes of Conduct outlined on pages 1 of 3 in the most recent version of the AB/NWT Competition Manual and any supporting rule book. The Drayton Valley Lifesavers Competition Committee will be responsible for enforcement of these codes.

	Anyone not adhering to the safety procedures as prescribed in the above-mentioned competition manuals may be disqualified or removed from the property. Unsafe actions and behaviours will not be tolerated.
<b>Contingency Plans</b>	All contingency plans are decided by the Drayton Valley Lifesavers Competition Committee. The committee has the right to postpone, reschedule, or cancel an event or competition if the venue is deemed unsafe.
<b>General Safety</b>	The Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre will adhere to the Alberta Legislation and Regulations as well as facility specific rules that will be followed for patron safety. Lifesaving Society Certified National Lifeguards will be supplied by the facility for the duration of the event. All general rules and procedures pertaining to competitions can be found in the most recent AB/NWT Competition Manual and any supporting documents.
<b>Major &amp; Minor Incidents</b>	The Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre staff will notify the appointed Safety Officer of any major incident that occurs on site including any drowning, resuscitation, suspected spinal injury and possible fracture. The Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre will be supervised by Lifesaving Society certified National Lifeguards that are employed by the Town of Drayton Valley. Employees will deal with emergencies per the Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre emergency procedures. The Drayton Valley Lifesavers Competition Committee will assist with managing the participants and volunteers during an emergency.
<b>Medical Facilities</b>	<p>On Site Service: All first aid services can be provided within the Ricochet Oil Corp. Aquatic Centre. It is at the discretion of the patient and/or Ricochet Oil Corp. <b>Warmups</b>	Athletes must observe all warm-up procedures in accordance with the Lifesaving Society Sanctioned Warm Up Procedures and the Drayton Valley Lifesavers event package. No equipment will be allowed during warmups. Fins will be allowed for diving only.
